A reminder about our school uniform policy

- Smart black shoes must be worn (not trainers);
- Grey or white socks or grey tights;

- We do not encourage earrings, if worn they must be a small gold or silver stud. Earrings cannot be worn for PE so your child must be able to remove them independently;
- Please also ensure your child has the appropriate PE kit for this cold weather;
- **ALL** uniform **must** be clearly labelled.

A reminder that we are a healthy school and encourage healthy eating. Infants are entitled to a free hot school lunch and Juniors are now able to purchase a lunch too, which is always freshly cooked using local produce.
