Welcome back everybody and a warm welcome to our new parents, children and the new staff who have joined Hutton All Saints' this term— Mrs. Richmond, Mr. Horne and Mrs. Goddard. It has been a busy start to the term as always, but it is lovely to see the children and staff refreshed and ready for an exciting year ahead.

We have had further developments to our school over the summer holidays. You will have noticed the new fencing and gates surrounding the school, making Hutton All Saints' a safer environment for our pupils.

The gates are electronic and are opened by the office staff. There is an entrance and exit system on each gate, so please push the videocom call button to gain entry. There is also an exit button on a green post, in front of the gate, on the right hand side. At the start and end of each day, the gate in Claughton Way will be open between the times of 7:45am - 8:50am and 3:00pm— 3:20pm. The gate in Coram Green should only be used for disabled access or if you need to see the office staff and have a buggy/pram. If you are collecting a child from year 3 or 4, please ensure you wait in the waiting area to keep the pathway clear around the school gates. Please also ensure young children do not play in the front garden.

A new boiler has been fitted in our boiler house, all asbestos has been removed and the new heating system is nearly complete, with final works taking place in October half term. This work was very important to ensure we stay warm in the winter!

I look forward to the exciting new year ahead and working with you all.

Thank you for taking the time to write to me


I'm very glad to hear you enjoy reading my books and that you've watched some of the adaptations on TV.

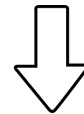
