When overtaking parked cars, watch out for car doors opening suddenly and allow room to pass safely.

Don't use headphones while cycling.

Never use a mobile phone while cycling.

The Year 6's have started their Bible Explorer lessons this week. They are learning about the New Testament in a fun and interactive way, over a period of 5 weeks.




