Please find attached the new club timetable for Autumn Term. If you would like your child to attend a club before or after school, application slips can be found at the bottom of this letter. We ask that children indicate their first, second and third choice for a club.

We then allocate places to each of the clubs, depending on these choices. **Please return slips by Tuesday 12th September.** All clubs will start the week commencing 18th September unless otherwise stated. Once allocated a place, your child will receive a slip from the teacher running the club to give you any other important information, such as where to collect your child after their club.

I would also like to remind you that once your child has committed to a club **they must be punctual** and if for any reason they cannot attend the club **they must inform the teacher who is running it with a letter from you also.** Please make a note of the **starting time** for our morning clubs as the teacher/coach can only let them in all at the same time.

We are continuing to broaden the range of competitive sports which are available to our children and, as a result, have enlisted qualified coaches to deliver certain clubs. These clubs are partially subsidised by our P.E. budget but we may also ask that parents make a contribution, which is indicated below where necessary.

Infant Clubs

Story Club

Story club is open to year 1 and 2 children. We will enjoy sharing a variety of stories and being creative.

French Club

French club is open to year 2 children. We will learn simple vocabulary and phrases through playing games and other fun activities, such as puppet making.

Board Games Club

In this club we will enjoy playing some traditional board games together and learning some new games.

For children in year 1 & 2. You will develop your football skills by playing fun and friendly games together.

For children in the juniors, we will be learning about the basics of cooking and preparing simple savoury and sweet dishes. A contribution of £8 towards the cost of the ingredients is needed for anyone taking part.

Digital Leaders

Mr Byles will again be inviting children from the juniors to work with him to learn about e-safety and lots of useful computing tips.

Boxercise

For children in the juniors who want to get or stay fit! We will be taking part in some high intensity aerobic sessions to develop our fitness and strength.

Book Club

Mrs Nott will be asking some children in years 5 and 6 if they are interested in forming a Book club, so that we can explore some more challenging texts. Letters will be coming out soon for those who will be invited to attend.
