In the first half of the term we will be looking at houses and homes. We will be exploring different types of homes, looking at how homes are made and will look at how homes differ around the world and over time.

Year two will be preparing for our National Curriculum Tests in English by learning how to demonstrate our comprehension skills and revising the spelling and grammar rules that we have already been taught. Following this work, we will be writing character descriptions and fantasy stories.

Year one are focusing on their understanding of grammar this term including adding suffixes and writing plural nouns. We will also be revising the sounds which we have learnt this year. We are writing our own texts based on 'A Squash and a Squeeze' by Julia Donaldson.

In maths, Year two will be looking again at the four operations and how to apply them in word problems. We will then be doing lots of maths investigations to deepen our understanding of what we have learnt this year.


Year one will be learning about money and how to problem solve and calculate using it. We will also be looking at each of the four operations again.
