



# Pear Class Curriculum Overview

## Topic

This term our topics are 'Houses and Homes' and 'Mini beasts and Ecosystems.' This half-term we will learn all about different types of homes where people live in the local area and around the world. Then, we will find out all about the different habitats of bugs and insects.

## English

This term we will be continuing with phase 5 phonics. We will focus on alternative pronunciations for phonemes such as /g/ in 'giraffe' or 'game'. During our English lessons, we will be looking at traditional tales, poetry and letter writing.



## P.E.

This term we will be enjoying our P.E. lessons outside. We will continue to have a weekly fitness session and we will be developing our skills in throwing and catching with our coach, in preparation for Sports Day.

## Maths

This half-term we will be developing our knowledge of place value, including counting forwards and backwards. We will then revise our number bonds to 20 as well as multiplication and division. Next half-term we will explore money and weight and volume.

## Computing

We will use laptops to create a simple algorithm this term as well as covering E-safety.

## R.E.

Our Christian values for this term are 'Perseverance', followed by 'Respect.' Throughout the term we will be learning about why the Bible is important to Christians and exploring different stories in it.

## Science

Following on from last term, we will continue to learn about types of weather. To finish the year, we will be finding out about different types of plants and what they are made up of.

## PSHE

This half-term we will be looking at managing risk, including sun safety. Then, next half-term we will be looking at relationships.



## Music

This half-term we will be continuing to play a steady beat with an instrument. Then, we will move onto exploring pitch.
