

Maths

This term in maths we will be:

- Exploring decimals and learning what happens when you divide a single digit number by 10 or 100.
- Measuring angles with a protractor and identifying whether they are acute, right or obtuse.
- Classifying triangles and quadrilaterals based on their properties and size.
- Identifying symmetry in shapes.
- Measuring length, mass and volume with the appropriate utensils.
- Interpreting data using graphs, bar charts, pictograms.

English

In English, we are learning how to write a letter. We will write a letter to our favourite author ensuring we follow the format learned in class. We will send our letters and hope for replies from the authors.

We will then look at poetry and write our own haiku and cinquain poems.

After half term we will be learning how to write in a persuasive style.

Topic

During the summer term, we will be finding out about different stories and festivals. This will closely link to our R.E. work where we will explore the different Hindu gods and goddesses and research the stories related to them, with a particular focus on Ganesh, Lakshmi and the Trimurti.

We will also learn about various festivals from around the world and different religions, including Independence Day, the May Day festival and Eid.

R.E.

Our values this term are truthfulness and service.

In RE this half term, we are fortunate to have Brentwood Christian Workers Trust teaching us about the Old Testament. Actions and role play are used to explore the stories in the Bible.

We will also be learning about Hinduism. We will learn how Hindus pray and worship and what it is like in a Mandir in preparation for our visit to Neasden Temple. This trip will really bring the learning to life.

Science

In Science this term, we will be learning about electricity. We will identify appliances that run on electricity, construct simple electrical circuits and recognise some common conductors and insulators.

We will then find out about animals, including humans. We will describe the functions of the digestive system, identify the different types of teeth in humans and will learn to construct food chains.

P.S.H.E.

We will identify physical, social and emotional risks. We will then develop a range of strategies to aid decision making in risky situations.

After half term, we will talk about managing change and explore the different emotions involved when we experience a big change in our lives.

P.E.

In P.E this term, we will be having athletics lessons with Mr Sims. This will help us to prepare for sports day. We will also be learning how to play rounders and how to express ourselves through dance.
